1. Educopia Conference Call
 - a. Katherine Skinner (attended the Madrid workshop) reached out to Maryann and Stephanie to schedule a phone call.
 - i. Educopia is trying to figure out how similar organizations can work together.
 - b. They are a proponent of collective action – a backbone organization that helps align efforts.
 - i. Maryann asked Katherine to write out some ideas of what she would like to do/see done in this area. This will be reviewed by the steering committee.
2. International SCWG Workshops (India & Sudan)
 - a. Very exciting that SCWG is seeding these workshops!
 - b. Using the FORCE11 name?
 - i. Leslie Chan forwarded this issue to the Board.
 1. Dan will discuss this issue further with Leslie and the rest of the Board.
 - ii. Generally, it is a cascaded branding – the workshops are an effect of the SCWG. They seem to be more of an offshoot of the WG rather than FORCE11 itself.
 1. The steering committee agreed that these workshops being associated with the SCWG is a good thing.
 2. We do want to know what the output of these offshoot groups are.
 - iii. **Action:** Jeroen will email the groups with our support and tell them that we would like to fold their output into our WG.

 - 1. There could potentially be money behind this, in terms of a prize/award.
 - 2. Purpose of the map: we want a conceptualization to find the next steps in the process of data flow for research, something that represents what we think the commons is and how it operates. It may be iterative.
 - 3. User specs – we want a group to create a visualization now using the current principles.
 - a. The group at FORCE2016 was very skilled at metaphorical thinking
 - 4. **Action:** Dan and Chris will compose a first draft for a call for teams to do this.

 - i. Nearly ready to submit to RIO; Jeroen and Bianca are taking one final pass on the article.
